



Statewide "Stay at Home" Executive Order

The California State Public Health Officer and Director of the California Department of Public Health is ordering all individuals living in the State of California to stay home or at their place of residence.

The Executive Order exempts operation of "critical infrastructure sectors", including transportation and logistics, as outlined in [guidance](#) issued by the Department of Homeland Security. Furthermore, the Executive Order explicitly states "the supply chain must continue".

In the Governor's press conference tonight, he indicated he is largely expecting voluntary compliance, but that enforcement actions could be taken in the future if necessary.

CTA staff is already working to seek further guidance and clarification from the federal and state governments. In the meanwhile, please heed this section of from the Department of Homeland Security guidance:

"Critical infrastructure industry partners will use their own judgment, informed by this list, to ensure continued operations of critical infrastructure services and functions. All decisions should appropriately balance public safety while ensuring the continued delivery of critical infrastructure services and functions."

It goes without saying that we are in uncharted territory. We urge our members to exercise your best judgment during these times and institute best practices to ensure our essential workforce remains healthy and that we can continue to keep the nation's supply chain moving.
