
I-80 TRUCK/BUS CHAIN REQUIREMENTS





NO EXCEPTIONS

Trucks/Buses are permitted in chain control areas when equipped with chains or Automatic Traction Device (ATD) as indicated.

Trucks/Buses with cable-type chains with less than 1/2" cross links are legal in California. However, these vehicles may be restricted at times due to local conditions.

The Department of Transportation reserves the right to prohibit any vehicle from entering a chain control area when it i determined the vehicle will experience difficulty in safely traveling the area.

- Caltrans may require chains on all drive wheels if conditions warrant

NOTES

- Trailers with brakes must have chains on on axle.
- Front-wheel drive vehicles must have chains on front (drive) axle.
- On any semi-trailer, only one set of chains is required regardlesss of number of axles.
- Chains are not required on tag axle.





- Cable traction devices maybe held during severe conditions.
- Single-drive trucks with dual trailers may restricted during severe conditions.

Any vehicle not meeting requirements for Min.-Max. Program must use CA-Standard Chart Requirements


















Tractor and Semi-trailer Type 3-S-2




Tractor, Semi-trailer, and Trailer Type 3-S-1-T-2


I-80 TRUCK MINIMUM - MAXIMUM PROGRAM - QUALIFICATIONS


- Must be a dual-drive axle truck (except Type 2 or 3 trucks bobtail or delivery vans
- Chains or cables MUST have minimum 1/2" diameter crosslinks
- During minimum requirements adequate chains must be in possession to meet maximum requirements

Any truck not meeting requirements for Program must chain up to California Standard Chain Requirements














Tractor and Semi-trailer Single Dr.



Tractor and Semi-trailer Type 3-S-2




Tractor, Semi-trailer, and Trailer Type 3-S-1-T-2








Truck Type 2




Tractor and Semi-trailer Single Dr.



Tractor and Semi-trailer Type 3-S-2




Tractor, Semi-trailer, and Trailer Type 3-S-1-T-2
